





Apple flavour wheel

What does an apple taste and smell like?

More than 1000 apple varieties offer a huge wealth of aroma, taste and texture.

The flavour wheel for apples can be experienced on three levels. The initial sensory sensation will be guided into the individual aroma family (fruity, green, floral, spicy, lactic, off-flavour) as well as into taste and texture. A quick orientation is provided by the illustration of the individual families inside the wheel.

Flavour families as well as taste and texture each contain subfamilies. These al-

low a further classification of the families, for example fruity notes into citrus, tropical, fruit, dried fruit and berry notes. A further precision is possible into the actual flavour (e.g. pineapple in tropical). The terms are both, scientific and suitable for everyday use.
